Stay connected with your loved ones

The Family & Friends Kit has been uniquely designed and developed to assist both families and Service Members during deployment. This Kit provides opportunities for families to stay more connected to their Service Members by using various tools designed to keep them up-to-date on what is happening at home while they are away. Experts say connection and positive communication are critical components of resiliency.

From Me to You Journal

is a way to capture your story to share. It is a keepsake for your Service Member and for generations to come. Share your life with your loved one while separated.

Photo Album

is for pictures of life at home. Include photos of special events, and remember to include everyday snapshots. Tucked inside the back cover there is an envelope to mail the albums to Service Members while they are serving our country.

Self-Mailers

are for longer letters. Write about whatever you like, but if you feel like you don't know what to say—just follow the prompt(s) and theme of the card.



Special Everyday Book

The Children's Kit has been uniquely designed and developed for Military Children of all ages to enhace resiliency and stay connected to their parent Service Member. The Children's Kit makes it easier for kids to share their lives ... their way ... with their parent who is away. This Kit has fun tools and activities in formats that children are used to, such as: fill in the blanks, coloring cards and answering questions in writing. Each item is designed to help children express their feelings.

All About Me Journal

captures a child's life as they see it at this moment in time, and becomes a book that is treasured by parents at home and away.

Canvas Pouch

is reusable with silk screen logo on front and back.

Self-Mailers

are for longer letters about what the kids are doing in and out of school. The prompts make it easier for children to fill in the blanks as they do in their workbooks.



Activity Book

is a doodle book designed to spark a child's imagination. They can spend as much time as they'd like filling it out. Each page can be an individual or a group endeavor. When the book is completed, slip it into the envelope provided, send it off, and Mom or Dad will receive some priceless works of creativity.

Flat Cards

make it simple to write a quick note, send an "I love you", or draw a picture. Some cards, like the black and white cards, can be colored on the front as well as the back.

Stickers

These tools help provide support to your loved one while he/she bravely travels the road to recovery.

Our Journey Journal

is a place to capture your thoughts and record your journey for you and your loved one. It often helps to record thoughts and feelings over time.

Flat Cards

make it simple to frequently write a quick or touching note and drop it in the mail to reinforce how much you are thinking about your loved one.

Self-Mailers

are for longer letters. Write about whatever you like, but if you feel like you don't know what to say—just follow the prompts.




Brighten Your Day Book

Photo Cards

For returning Service Members

Service Members coming home after deployment have unique challenges to handle. The Soldier's Reintegration Kit was developed (based on research) to address those special needs. The Kit engages the users in thoughts, actions and practices that are the building blocks of resiliency, connection, and effective communication.

In Action Book

This book is filled with action steps to assist Service Members in the transition home by helping them to reconnect at work, at home, and in their communities. Every item calls for positive action to enhance one's sense of well being.

Thought Cards

Sometimes it is hard to know what to say or how to say it, particularly after a long deployment. The Thought Cards take out all the angst and make it easy for returning Service Members to share their thoughts and feelings in a positive way. Just pick a card and give it to a friend or loved one -- it says it all for you.



The Journal

This personal journal is specially designed for Service Members to use when they get home following deployment. It is structured with sections and prompts to support Service Members' reintegration and promote resiliency.

Thank You Cards

These cards make it easy to show appreciation for others.

Follow-up Cards

The follow-up cards help Service Members reconnect with their friends and communities.

Service Members & Families reconnect at home

The Reconnection Kit is based on extensive research with families of deployed Service Members. Each item was designed to address unique and specific post deployment issues. Reconnecting after an extended absence takes time and patience. This Kit gently guides Family Members and Service Members through getting reacquainted and re-assimilated into family routines.

Reconnection Calendar

is a simple, engaging way to reorient the returning hero to the swing of the family schedule. An 18-month calendar with stickers provides a snapshot of activities and scheduling suggestions.

"Who Am I Now" Trifolds

provide a forum for Service Members and their Family Members to positively communicate how they've changed during their time apart.

Coupon Books

are filled with fun ideas for "redeemable" relationship building activities--making the transition into family life easier. One book for Family Members and one book for Service Members.

Stickers

to add a little something extra to any card/ book or use to seal the trifolds.



Canvas Pouch

a convenient, reusable pouch to hold all the communication tools.

My Journal

is specially designed for returning Service Members. Charting a course after deployment can be a challenge. This journal is structured to capture returning Service Members thoughts and provide a compass to navigate a positive future.

"Conversation Starters"

help Family Members and Service Members catch-up after deployment. Sometimes it is difficult to talk about what has happened during the time apart. These cards gently guide the Service Members and Families into easy topics to break the ice and reconnect their lives.

"Hard to Share Feeling Cards"

make it easy to let loved ones know how you feel when words are difficult to find. Slip small cards into a pocket, purse or a lunch box to express just how much your loved ones mean to you.

For couples reconnecting

Communication is the foundation of a strong relationship. With increasing demands placed on Military Families, couples' relationships are strongly tested. The Couples Kit supplies communication tools to help couples successfully reestablish and deepen their connection to each other. All of the tools are specially designed to complement the Yellow Ribbon Program, in thoughtful and fun ways. The kits can be used at home or while at the program.

Journal: My life story for you ...

This book is designed to make it fun and easy for couples to tell their life story (so far). Where they came from ... where they are now ... and how they got there. Deployments cause physical and sometimes emotional separation. This book is designed to help bridge time and distance by sharing information, insights and incidents. Memories that uniquely create their lives -- define their lives. Not only will this journal be a great gift for each spouse, it also provides a keepsake for generations to come.

"Who Am I Now" Cards

After deployment, many things change for the Soldier and for the Family at home. Sometimes it is hard to express what is different. These cards provide a thoughtful way for participants to share themselves with their partners. "Who Am I Now" cards help couples capture and share in a loving way how they have grown and changed since deployment.



Vision & Dream Book

After long deployments many things change. The Vision & Dream book provides a great platform for couples to create their vision of their future-from where they are now. The prompts and imagery are designed to help participants create and have fun as they capture their dreams together!

Appreciation Cards

Everyone loves being appreciated; these cards make it easy for couples to show how much they appreciate each other.

Listening Game

Some say the biggest gift you can give someone is your focused listening. This game helps couples and family members share and catch up in a positive way, by making listening fun.

The tools are specially designed to complement the Youth Challenge Program.

Doodle Art Activity Book

is an activity book designed to spark the participants imaginations and creativity as they engage. Themes of the activities will reinforce core program ideas in fun ways. Each page can be an individual or group endeavor. When the book is completed, it becomes a keepsake.


